


**TRUSTEE'S FINAL REPORT, APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION



The Court finds that the Application was properly served pursuant to the Federal and Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and that it contained the appropriate twenty (20)-day negative notice language, pursuant to Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9007, which directed any party opposed to the granting of the relief sought by the Application to file a written response within twenty days or the Application would be deemed by the Court to be unopposed. The Court finds that no objection or other written response to the Application has been timely filed by any party. Due to the failure of any party to file a timely written response, the allegations contained in the Application stand unopposed, and upon its review of the Application, the Court finds that good cause exists for the entry of the following order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Trustee be authorized to pay PROVOST UMPHREY, L.L.P., as an administrative expense, compensation for legal services rendered as Special Counsel for the Trustee, a contingency fee of forty percent (40%) of the gross recovery for each settled claim for the sum of \$31,326.33, and reimbursement of expenses in the sum and amount of \$545.75, for a total of fees and expenses of \$31,972.08, and that the same be paid from the funds of this estate upon execution thereof.




BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority on this date personally appeared Stephen J. Zayler, and under oath stated the following:


