

5. There is no agreement or understanding between the Trustee and any other person for a division of the compensation sought by this application except as permitted by the Bankruptcy Code.


6. The Trustee requests approval of this final report.

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
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ORDER AUTHORIZING EMPLOYMENT OF ATTORNEY





ON THIS DATE the Court considered the "Application for Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses for Counsel for the Trustee Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. Section 330" filed by Stephen J. Zayler, ("Applicant") attorneys for the Chapter 7 Trustee, Stephen J. Zayler, in the above-referenced Chapter 7 case. The Court, having reviewed the Application and determined whether the services and expenses as outlined in the application were actual, reasonable and necessary, finds that a reduction of .80 attorney hours [.30 hr on 11-28-01 and .50 hr. on 2-24-03] is justified for excessive time having been billed for the work described. Accordingly, the Court finds that just cause exists for the entry of the following order.






