Major activities affecting case closing which are not reflected above, and matters pending, date of hearing or sale, and other action:

As of date TFR submitted to UST: 10/28/11: This case was originally filed 08/30/04 and was reopened to administer on 09/30/09 (docket #29). The one asset administered was the Celebrex/Bextra claim of the Debtor-husband against Merck & Co. Inc. The Watts Law Firm contacted the Trustee to inform the estate of a possible cause of action. Settlement was reached and funds deposited to estate. See settlement motion/order dockets #38/40 on 07/23/10 and 08/20/10 respectively.

Terms were for a gross settlement of \$10,000 with approximately \$4,421.53 net to the estate. Special counsel and general counsel fees and expenses approved by the Court and paid. Of note is that there are no claims filed in this case. Trustee attempted multiple times to alert creditors to file claims. In addition to the Court's notice, the Trustee mailed letters to creditors on 09/28/10, 02/23/11, and 07/14/11. Telephone calls up to the last call from trustee on 09/15/11 to selected creditors indicated they had written off claims, could not locate claims, and ultimately would not file claims due to age, charge-off, or inability to locate claims. Trustee proposes back to debtor surplus as indicated in the proposed distribution of the final report.
