**ORDER GRANTING IN PART AND DENYING IN PART
APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION AND
REIMBURSEMENT OF EXPENSES FOR SEARCY & SEARCY, P.C.,
ATTORNEYS FOR CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE**

ON THIS DATE the Court considered the Application for Allowance of Compensation and Reimbursement of Expenses filed by Searcy & Searcy, P.C. f/k/a Jason R. Searcy & Associates, P.C. and f/k/a Jason R. Searcy, P.C. ("Applicant"), attorneys for the Chapter 7 Trustee, Jason Searcy, in the above-referenced Chapter 7 case. The Court, having reviewed the Application and determined whether the services and expenses as outlined in the application were actual, reasonable and necessary, finds that a reduction of 1.0 senior attorney hours and 12.1 junior attorney hours [.40 @ \$200/hr. and 11.7 @\$175/hr.] is justified for excessive time having been billed for the work described. The Court further finds that a reduction of 1.10 paraprofessional hours is justified for clerical-type services, including the electronic filing of documents, which are properly characterized as an overhead item. Accordingly, the Court finds that just cause exists for the entry of the following order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Searcy & Searcy, P.C., as attorneys for the Chapter 7 Trustee in the above-referenced case, is hereby awarded the sum of \$10,810.50 as reasonable compensation for actual and necessary services rendered to the Chapter 7 Estate and reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses in the amount of \$2,005.87, for a total award of \$12,816.37 which the Chapter 7 Trustee shall pay from available funds to Searcy & Searcy, P.C.
