ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR PAYMENT OF POST-PETITION
TAXES FOR 2007 TO INTERNAL REVENUE SERVICE
FILED BY JASON R. SEARCY, TRUSTEE

On March 11, 2008, a Motion for Payment of Post-Petition Taxes for 2007 to Internal Revenue Service (the "Motion") was filed by Jason R. Searcy, Trustee (the "Movant") in the above-referenced case. The Court finds that the Motion was properly served pursuant to the Federal and Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure and that it contained the appropriate twenty (20) day negative notice language, pursuant to Local Rule of Bankruptcy Procedure 9007, which directed any party opposed to the granting of the relief sought by the Motion to file a written response within twenty days or the Motion would be deemed by the Court to be unopposed. The Court finds that no objection or other written response to the Motion has been timely filed by any party. Due to the failure of any party to file a timely written response, the allegations contained in the Motion stand unopposed and, therefore, the Court finds that good cause exists for the entry of the following order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion for Payment of Post-Petition Taxes for 2007 to Internal Revenue Service filed by Jason R. Searcy, Trustee on March 11, 2008 is hereby granted; and;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that Jason R. Searcy, Trustee for the estate of Tyler

Consolidated, Inc., is hereby authorized to pay to the Internal Revenue Service the amount of \$30.07 plus future assessment of penalty and interest, for delayed payment of the Debtor's 2007 post-petition corporation tax assessment/obligation.
