As date TFR submitted to UST: 03/05/13: The one asset administered was the 15 acres in Sulphur Springs, Texas. Trustee hired general counsel and a realtor to assist with the sale of the rural property in late 2011. Trustee and realtor sold property for \$25,000 and net proceeds deposited to estate bank account. Accountant required due to amount above exemption limits for joint filers. Tax return accepted as filed and claims review/objections completed. Note: Debtors previously filed Chapter 13, case #11-41277. They claimed this property as exempt in that case, but no longer lived there when this case was filed. They testified they moved to another property and elected to exempt that property as their homestead, leaving this property as nonexempt and for the estate to adminisiter. Trustee confirmed there is no lien on the property as stated on the chapter 7 schedules.
