If no objection to the Final Report is timely filed and served, the Trustee may pay dividends contemplated by the Final Report pursuant to FRBP 3009 without further order of the Court. In such event, the notice required under FRBP 5009 shall be deemed satisfied and the presumption contemplated by that rule shall be invoked upon the filing of the Trustee's certification that the estate has been fully administered in the Trustee Distribution Report.

If a written objection is filed in either instance, a hearing shall be scheduled and the Court will send notice of the scheduled hearing to you.
