On this day came on for consideration the Application for Allowance of Final Attorney's Fees and Reimbursement of Expenses filed by counsel for the Trustee, for services performed between April 24, 1997 and October 8, 1998. Applicant has requested \$ 6,547.50 in fees and \$ 36.41 in out-of-pocket expenses.

Having considered the Application, together with the record before the Court, the Court is of the opinion that Applicant is entitled to compensation in the amount set forth below. This Order contains the Court's findings of fact and conclusions of law, as required by Bankruptcy Rule 7052 and 9014.

Debtors filed thier voluntary petition under Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code on or about November 15, 1996. Debtor's case was converted to a proceeding under Chapter 7 of the Bankruptcy Code on April 22, 1997. Joyce W. Lindauer is the duly appointed Chapter 7 Trustee in this proceeding. Applicant's employment as attorney for the Trustee has been initially approved by the Court.

The Court in In Re First Colonial Corp. of America, 544 F.2d 1291, 1299 (5th Cir. 1977), cert. denied, 431 U.S. 904 (1977), establishes the proper procedure for determining attorney fee awards in bankruptcy. The Court first determine the "nature and extent of the services supplied by the attorney." Id. The attorney seeking fees should file a specific written

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statement and description of the hours worked. If any factual disputes exists, the Court must conduct an evidentiary hearing.

Second, the Court must assess the value of the attorney's services. The two factors are called the "lodestar". See Cobb v. Miller, 818 F.2d 1227, 1231 (5th Cir. 1987). Generally, the lodestar is calculated by multiplying the number of hours reasonably extended by the reasonable hourly rate. Lawler v. Teofan (In re Lawler), 807 F.2d 1207, 1221 (5th Cir. 1987).

Finally, the Court must explain the basis for its award. In doing so, the Court must briefly describe its findings and explain an analysis of the Johnson v. Georgia Highway Express, Inc., 488 F.2d 714 (5th Cir. 1974), factors lead to its decision.

Applicant will be compensated at the requested hourly rates. These rates are their customary rates and comparable to the rates charged by comparable attorneys in similar bankruptcy and non-bankruptcy cases. These rates compare favorably to the rates charged in other similar bankruptcy and non-bankruptcy cases. No adjustments will be made.

The Court also finds the work performed was necessary for the proper administration of this Estate. Although, not a large case, it presented counsel with several different, difficult issues, relating to the operations of the Debtor and in negotiating with various Creditors of the Estate, to achieve an orderly liquidation of the assets and a payment to creditor's of a dividend in accordance with the priorities under the bankruptcy code.

Applying the Johnson factors, the Court finds that an adjustment to the lodestar is not warranted. Specifically, the Court finds that the amount of hours charged were reasonable and necessary for the property administration of Debtor's Estate, and the hourly rate charged was within the hourly rates charged by comparable attorneys in comparable cases and is Applicant's customary rate; and that Applicant is an experienced bankruptcy counsel. Applicant has

vigorously prosecuted this case in an efficient matter. The results obtained justify the fees requested. None of the other Johnson factors are applicable. Upon the foregoing reasons, it is

ORDERED that the Final Application for Allowance of Attorneys Fees is hereby Granted and that attorney's fees of \$ 6,547.50 and out-of-pocket expenses of \$ 36.41 are hereby GRANTED to Applicant for legal services performed on behalf of the Trustee.
