


**TRUSTEE'S FINAL REPORT, APPLICATION FOR COMPENSATION AND

Dear Mr. Campbell:

This letter is being written to you per your request regarding the above referenced case. The debtors filed a voluntary petition under Chapter 7, Title 11 United States Bankruptcy Code. I was subsequently appointed as the interim Trustee. A 341 Meeting was held on October 15, 1999. I believed there were assets in this estate to be administered for the benefit of creditors including three oil change compressors, three oil change trailers and inventory. There were no secured creditors listed with liens on these assets.


An order was entered employing auctioneer and an order was entered on the Trustee's Application to Sell Property of the Estate. An auction was held and gross proceeds of the estate totaled \$7,240.00.

On or about March 27, 2000, Darrell W. and Tami L. Patterson filed a lawsuit against me claiming an interest in the compressors and trailers. There was a dispute over whether the assets were owned by the Youngs individually, or a corporation in which the Pattersons claimed to hold the stock. We verbally agreed that if the Pattersons would dismiss their complaint, we would work out an agreement on the proceeds of the sale. We agreed to split the proceeds 50% - 50%. A sale was conducted by the auctioneer and the proceeds were split 50% - 50%. Throughout this process it was not known how much would be realized from a sale. After the sale and the proceeds were paid and the TFR was prepared, we had the information pulled together to see how much was available. It was originally thought that the compressors and trailers would sell for much more than \$7,240.00 These items were scheduled with a value of \$26,000.00. An order was entered approving the settlement with the Pattersons. Pursuant to the Court's Order, we disbursed funds to the Pattersons in the amount of \$3,620.00. An Application for Compensation of Auctioneer was filed and an Order was granted on January 31, 2001 approving his

compensation.

Finally, we prepared a final report and submitted the same to the United States Trustee's Office in April, 2001. I hope this letter will assist in clarifying the reasons to disburse funds to the Pattersons in connection with the approved settlement before the Final Report.






