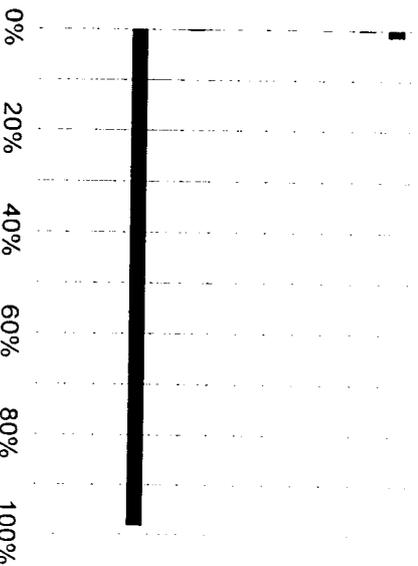

Due to the failure of any party to file a timely written response, the allegations contained in the Motion stand unopposed and, therefore, the Court finds that good cause exists for the entry of the following order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion for Payment of Post-Petition Taxes to Internal Revenue Service filed by Jason R. Searcy, Trustee on March 13, 2000 is hereby granted; and;

BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that Jason R. Searcy, Trustee for the estate of Berry Transportation, Inc. is hereby authorized to pay to the Internal Revenue Service the amount of \$46.26

plus future assessment of penalty and interest, for delayed payment of the Debtor's 1999 post-petition corporation tax assessment/obligation.

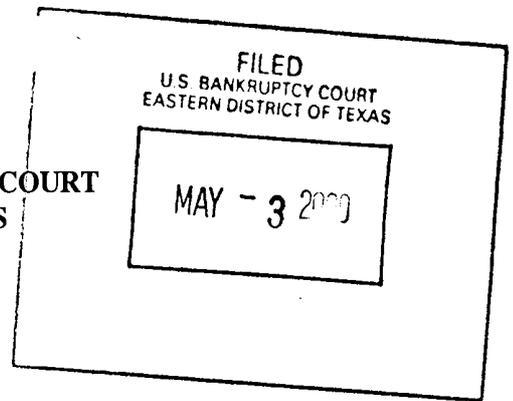
