**GENERAL ORDER 01-1
FEES FOR PRINTING AT PUBLIC ACCESS TERMINALS AND
PRINTERS AT THE BANKRUPTCY COURT**

In recognition of the onerous burden upon the staff of Clerk's Office by a strict requirement to charge ten cents per page for the printing of all electronic documents by the public, and in recognition of the desirability of providing unimpeded access to Court electronic data to the public, and in recognition that one free electronic document copy will be provided to anyone legally entitled to service, and in recognition of the necessity to insure the prompt and efficient administration of bankruptcy cases in this District, and in recognition that this overall administration of bankruptcy cases would be enhanced if the public were to be granted a limited exemption from the fee normally imposed for the printing of an electronic page and that exemptions have been authorized by the Judicial Conference of the United States, as set forth in the Judicial Conference Advisory Notes to the Electronic Public Access Miscellaneous Fee Schedule,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that an exemption for the ten cents per page fee for printing an electronic document at the courthouse is hereby **GRANTED** to

(1) any member of the public who prints ten or fewer total pages during a single visit to the courthouse,

(2) any member of the panel of private trustees, who serve as trustees in cases under chapter 7 of Title 11, United States Code, in the Eastern District of Texas, as established and hereafter maintained by the Office of the United States Trustee for Region VI, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. Section 586(a)(1),

(3) any individual appointed by the Office of the United States Trustee for Region VI, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. Section 586(b), to serve as a standing trustee in cases under chapter 12 or chapter 13 of Title 11, United States Code, in the Eastern District of Texas,

(4) any individual on the staff of the Office of the United States Trustee for Region VI.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this authorization is in addition to and shall in no way affect the exemptions from fees for usage of electronic access to court data previously granted by this Court.
