DECEMBER 1, 2016**

- Rule 7016. Pretrial Procedures
- Rule 9006. Computing and Extending Time; Time for Motion Papers
- Rule 9027. Removal
- Rule 9033. Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law
