
GENERAL ORDER 11-3

**GENERAL ORDER CONCERNING APPORTIONMENT OF CERTAIN
ADVERSARY PROCEEDINGS IN THE SHERMAN DIVISION**

In accordance with 28 U.S.C. §154 and the agreement of the Judges affected hereby, the Court finds that a portion of the adversary proceedings filed in the Sherman Division should be assigned to Judge Bill Parker in an effort to equalize the docket between its judges. Trial of such adversary proceedings and all related hearings, excepting those set on an emergency basis or set as a telephonic hearing, shall be conducted within the geographical confines of the Sherman Division. Accordingly, the Court finds cause for entry of this order.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, effective as of June 1, 2011, that all adversary proceedings relating to a discharge under 11 U.S.C. §727 or dischargeability of debt under 11 U.S.C. §523 [causes of action with code nos. 41, and 61-68 on the Adversary Proceeding Cover Sheet] filed in the Sherman Division shall be assigned to Judge Bill Parker until further order of this Court.
