**RESCISSION OF GENERAL ORDER 05-2 REGARDING
ADOPTION OF INTERIM BANKRUPTCY RULES**

In recognition of the fact that the revised Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, designated to become effective on December 1, 2008, have now incorporated rule amendments reflecting the substantive and procedural changes mandated by the passage of the Bankruptcy Abuse Prevention and Consumer Protection Act of 2005 (the "Act"); and the fact that the Interim Bankruptcy Rules previously promulgated by the Advisory Committee on Bankruptcy Rules of the Judicial Conference of the United States, and adopted by this Court through General Order 05-2 shall be superseded by such amendments to the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure,

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that General Order 05-2 of this Court, under which the Interim Bankruptcy Rules were adopted as a subset of the Local Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure, is hereby **RESCINDED** in its entirety.
