- 2. Refinish separator doors ("swinging doors") in the courtroom (match existing stain)
- 3. Refinish/restore 2 entrance doors (both sides) to the courtroom facing the hallway outside of the courtroom
- 4. Touch up highly visible scuffs and scratches on all other wood work in the courtroom and attorney work rooms (match existing stain)
- 5. Clean and polish all furniture including a round table in Judge's office and 3 cabinets in chambers suite
- 6. Fix chip on Judicial Assistant desk
- 7. Level cabinet doors on 2 cabinets in chambers suite (Judge's office) to open and close properly
- 8. Modify 2 attorney podiums in Courtroom (Room 304) to accommodate larger monitors
