**NOTICE OF TRANSITION TO MULTI-FACTOR  
AUTHENTICATION FOR CM/ECF AND PACER USERS**

Case Management/Electronic Case Files (CM/ECF) and Public Access to Court Electronic Records (PACER) will begin transitioning to Multi-Factor Authentication (MFA) in mid-May. MFA provides an added layer of security to accounts by helping protect against cyberattacks that steal passwords, significantly reducing the risk of unauthorized access.

After implementation, all CM/ECF users with filing and/or other types of CM/ECF-level access will be required to enroll in MFA. Users with PACER-only access will have the option to enroll.
