NOTICE OF ALTERNATIVE MEANS OF ACCESS TO BANKRUPTCY COURT SERVICES IN RESPONSE TO THE COVID-19 OUTBREAK

Out of concern for the safety and health of our community and to make every effort to mitigate the spread of coronavirus (COVID-19), the United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Texas offers alternative means of doing business with the court in lieu of physically coming to the courthouse.

Authorized ECF users may continue to use the ECF system for conducting business with the court. For those without access to the ECF system, email is an acceptable temporary means to file a new case or pleading; mail is an acceptable method to pay court fees; and as always, we are available by phone during normal business hours to answer questions.

We encourage those without access to the ECF system to use our emergency filing email address, <u>emergencyfiling@txeb.uscourts.gov</u>, to submit new petitions and other filings. Clerk's Office staff will contact the filing party with further guidance on paying fees associated with the filing and curing any deficiencies.
