**NOTICE OF NEW AND MODIFIED NEXTGEN CM/ECF EVENTS FOR  
DOCKETING CHAPTER 11 NON-SMALL BUSINESS PERIODIC REPORTS**

On December 21, 2020, the U.S. Trustee Program (USTP) promulgated a final rule, "Procedures for Completing Uniform Periodic Reports in Non-Small Business Cases Filed Under Chapter 11 of Title 11." The new rule, which is authorized by 28 U.S.C. § 589b, requires that chapter 11 debtors in possession and trustees — other than small business debtors — file monthly operating reports (MORs) and post-confirmation reports (PCRs) using streamlined, data-embedded, uniform forms in every case in every judicial district where the USTP operates. The United States Bankruptcy Court for the Eastern District of Texas will make available the following new events to accommodate the new USTP rule on June 21, 2021:

1. Operating Report (Chapter 11 Non-Small Business Debtor Only)
2. Post-Confirmation Report (Chapter 11 Non-Small Business Debtor Only)

The applicable forms and new events identified above should be used by Chapter 11 non-small business debtors to file post-confirmation and operating reports on or after June 21, 2021.

The following modified events will direct Chapter 11 non-small business debtors to use the above-mentioned events when filing operating and post-confirmation reports:

1. Operating Report (Chapter 11 Small Business)
2. Post-Confirmation Report (Chapter 11)
